

## THE COTTAGE

When you see the 'Cottage' you will fall in love. Charming and romantic, the original cabin was a Hunter's cabin located in Oak Creek Canyon. Built in the 50's, and moved to the Dickison Ranch, it was renovated and remodeled into a two bedroom two bath home by the Dickison's and Miller's. They lived in the cottage while building the present house now known as the Dream Maker Owner's personal Home.

The cottage is a separate residence, and has it's own address! There is a wonderful porch out front, and a cozy tea room in the back, where you can cuddle up and read your favorite book or have tea with your special friends. Surrounded by pine trees and native vegetation, you are tucked away, and can feel the stillness wrap around you. With a living space of 904 Square Feet, you are completely comfortable.

## OWNER'S RESIDENCE

This wonderful log home is elegant, yet warm and inviting with walls of wood, stone fireplace, spacious windows that flood the rooms with light and soaring ceilings of log and pine - unique and truly wonderful! The hardwood flooring adds a richness to the overall space, and there are porches and decks that offer cozy nooks to relax and enjoy the views, and the numerous critters that come to visit. The logs used are full rounds, and were from our local area. The cabinets in the kitchen are beautifully hand-crafted pine, and there is even a 'heart' stone that was woven into the fireplace

rocks - a gift from Mr. Dickison to Mrs. Dickison. The home was completed over a period of years and finished in 1975. It offers three bedrooms and two bathrooms and a world of comfort. It is sepatated from the Dream Maker Bed and Breakfast Inn by french doors, so you have privacy for your personal spaces. There is well over 2,000 Sq.Ft. of living PLUS a workshop area to the back. The kitchen has a head-on view of Bell Rock, so you won't mind doing the dishes at the sink!

### THE DREAM MAKER BED AND BREAKFAST INN

The present Owner's purchased this property from the Miller's - they are only the second Owner's of this home. They moved here in 2001, and loved the home for it's space, 1.69 acres of land, the wonderful Art Gallery/Studio, small barn and corral, and the possibilities. When speaking with the County about additional structures, the County suggested creating a Bed and Breakfast Inn - so three beautifully appointed and elegant rooms were added to the Owner's home. Milled logs from Maine were brought in, and Michael and his local crew that knew how to create something magical with logs, went to work. With the Owner's help and direction, these spacious guest rooms took shape - soaring ceilings mirror the Owner's home, and porches and large windows welcome the views and quiet spaces. The furniture is custom - truly hand-crafted works of art - you have to see them to appreciate the fine quality and one-of-a-kind uniqueness. The bathrooms are designed for each room, with separate tubs and showers with hand-painted tiles. The room sizes are very generous, and you feel so welcomed, you'll want to stay a month!

There are hammocks, a tepee, a "King Chair", trails and benches everywhere on the property. One of my favorite places is the incredible 360 degree viewing deck, which captures Bell Rock, Courthouse Butte, Red Butte, Wild Horse Mesa and much more! The Dream Maker Inn offers elegance, comfort and charm.

In the early days the Native Americans used this site for purification ceremonies prior to making the journey to Bell Rock, which they considered a sacred space.
